

ENOFORUM, Europe's largest technical-scientific congress for the wine sector, comes to CHILE.

ENOFORUM is an international event, known for its content and reach, and has been proposed for 20 years with great success in Italy, Spain, Portugal and, more recently, in the USA.

The conference **ENOFORUM on the ROAD** brings together the 3 pillars which are necessary to have an effective innovation process:

- Research in public institutions
- R&D activity by auxiliary industries/supplier companies
- Front-runner winegrowing professionals

ENOFORUM on the ROAD is a **travelling version of the Enoforum concept** aimed to present technological innovations developed in Europe to key stakeholders of the local wine industry. In particular, the Chilean 2023 edition will be attended by a panel of 80-100 industry actors, composed of:

- Vineyard, cellar, and R&D managers of the largest wine groups in Chile (Concha y Toro, Viña Santa Rita, Viña San Pedro, etc.)
- Advisors and opinion leaders dealing with medium and small grape and wine producers
- Representatives of local institutions, associations, business support organisations, etc.

At **ENOFORUM** on the **ROAD** the participating **European supplier companies** will be able to showcase the result of **their innovative solutions** to Chilean wine industry decision-makers, through a conference presentation of the technology, the experience of a European wine producer who has tested and applied the innovation, and an informal tasting of an outstanding wine produced by the testimonial winery.

COMPANY PARTICIPATION



Enoforum reserves a significant space in the program for supplier companies, recognising that they play a fundamental role in the evolution of the sector by bridging the gap between research and practice, through the development of new technologies, making the results of research applicable in practice, thus transforming knowledge into innovation.

The other part of the event is dedicated to the transfer of recent scientific knowledge to the production world by offering a scientific update to wine professionals. Each participating company will have the following spaces to explain its innovative solution:

CONFERENCE SESSION

The conference program will reserve 15-20 minutes to each company for:

- A presentation of the **innovative solution** developed and of its effects in grape and wine production
- A testimonial from a wine / grape producer who applies the innovation, explaining reasons and results of its adoption

To be the most appreciated by and attractive for the qualified attendance, the session should only address one solution and should present technical characteristics innovation presented, with documented material issued from the experimental work performed during its development.

It is advised to arrange for the in-person presence of at least one Spanish-speaking speaker, although simultaneous translation from English to Spanish and video-conference options (*) will also be available. Broadcasting of a recorded video will also be possible.

DIRECT EXCHANGES VIA WINE TASTINGS

Each company will have an available space & table where it can offer a tasting of an outstanding wine produced by the winery that spoke to their interest of the solution explained during the conference showcasing the company's innovation.

The conference attendees will be invited to divide into small groups and visit the tasting spaces, according to a predefined schedule. The attractiveness of the proposed tasting will depend on the interest for the innovation and on the reputation of the winery and the originality of the wine for the participants.

This tasting will allow:

- The attendees to better understand the technical. environmental. and socioeconomic context in which the innovation is applied.
- The company representative(s) pouring the wine to add details on the applicative of the innovation. aspects and to establish direct contacts with local stakeholders.

Translation services will not be provided during the tasting sessions.

CONDITIONS & REGISTRATION

Each company has the possibility to participate solely in Enoforum on the Road, or Enoforum on the Road Chile + the mission in Chile + the mission in Argentina. Thanks to the support of the European Union, WICA by EPAWI and Enoforum can propose the following estimated prices for participation, based on the participation of a minimum number of companies, and on the condition that the company is an SME (1,2) and has participated in the EPAWI crowd-writing exercise (3). A down payment will be necessary at the time of official registration. Extra funding to compensate for part of the mission and travel is provided to SMEs who have participated in the EPAWI crowd-writing contest.
